TRAC MEMBER NOMINATION FOR 2016-2018 TERM Staff Selection Committee Recommendations

On Friday, October 23, 2015, PSTA staff met to review 20 applications received for the following open seats on the Transit Riders Advisory Committee (TRAC).

- Alternate North County
- Mid County (2)
- Alternate Mid County
- South County (2)
- Alternate South County
- Student
- Professional
- Alternate Professional

Below are the staff recommendations including background information for each applicant.

Alternate North: David Kovar

(White 56-year-old male)

Mr. Kovar is a community activist with in high level of interest in public transportation and urban concerns. He has been extensively engaged with PSTA using his own resources. He has used transit systems throughout the world and has an excellent knowledge of transit policy and procedure. He is active in the FAST Coalition, Humanist Society, Sierra Club, and many other organizations.

Mid: Elizabeth Olden

(White 50-year-old female)

Ms. Olden is a scooter-bound DART user. She is a volunteer in the public school system and is also active in ARC Foundation, a Foundation serving individuals with intellectual disabilities. Ms. Olden has observed much public criticism but little activism and feels she can help by becoming a transit advocate and engaging riders.

Mid: Jason Stephens

(White 43-year-old male)

Mr. Stephens has previously served as a volunteer for the Kansas GOP and has volunteered in many campaigns on the local, state and federal level. He holds an MBA and is now retired. Mr. Stephens feels he knows the system well and would like to be an advocate to help others with transit.

Alternate Mid: Chelsea Schneiter (Hispanic 52-year-old female)

Although new to the area, Ms. Schneiter is actively riding the bus and learning the system. She suffers from MS but is not a DART client. She has been an active volunteer with the library system, her church, the Clearwater Marine Aquarium, and teaches computer classes in a 55 plus community. She is interested in becoming further involved with the community, particularly public transit.

South: Robyn Pierce

(Hispanic 37-year old female)

Ms. Pierce retired from the military last year and became a transit user after being diagnosed with Post Traumatic Stress Disorder. Although her condition is now under control, she continues to use public transit as a preference for getting to work. She is employed at Bayfront Hospital, volunteers with the St. Vincent de Paul Society and is a member of the Wounded Warrior Project. Her enthusiasm for public transit as an option is something she wants to share with others in the community.

South: Julie DiPietrantonio

(White 66-year old female)

Ms. DiPietrantonio has been active in various entities concerned with children such as Children First, Council for Exceptional Children and the National Association for the Education of young Children. She works as an early childhood education consultant and has a history of work with non-profit agencies serving low-income disadvantaged families. Ms. DiPietrantonio is an active user of the CAT and wants to become more involved in transit issues.

Alternate South: Elise Gilmore

(Ethnicity unknown, 42-year old female)

Ms. Gilmore is very active in urban affairs and keeps a Facebook blog page about urban issues, including transit. She is a member of the St. Pete Bike Co-op program, and has been involved in the Board of Ringling College Library Association Town Hall Lecture Series and on the Board of the Democratic Club of Sarasota. She holds a Masters of Environmental Law and Policy and has an interest in getting more professionals to use the transit system.

Student: Catherine Baranowski

(White, 26 year-old female)

Ms. Baranowski is currently an Alternate member of TRAC. She is a student of Criminology attending USF and has applied to fill the Student position being vacated by Demetrius Sullivan whose term expires at the end of 2015. As well as attending school, she is a professional who chooses to use public transportation for economic and environmentally friendly living purposes. She has also been active in the development of a student organization to support USF (St. Pete) PSTA riders and their needs. Ms. Baranowski joined the committee at the beginning of the year and immediately became a valued and active TRAC member, contributing intelligently and insightfully to discussions and decisions.

<u>Professional</u>: Carson Zimmer (White, 26 year-old male)

Mr. Zimmer is currently an Alternate member of TRAC. He has applied to fill the Professional position being vacated by Jaksa Petrovic whose term expires at the end of 2015. Mr. Carson worked as an intern for PSTA in 2014 working on public outreach and marketing. He uses the 100X to travel to and from work every day. This experience, plus his year on the TRAC Committee where his contributions have always been insightful and valuable provide excellent qualifications to continue to represent TRAC.

Alt. Professional: David Schneider

(Ethnicity and age unknown)

Mr. Schneider is a teacher for a magnet school, specializing in Science, Technology, Engineering and Math. He serves as a commissioner on the Florida Education Practices Commission where he leads panel discussions. He is interested in being engaged with public committees and is interested in public transportation, seeing it as a key element in the infrastructure of a city, region and state. He enjoys working with residents and visitors, helping them learn about the bus system. He is well traveled and has used public transit a many major cities. He is a fan of the real-time system and WiFi on the bus and applauds PSTA's use of technology.

PSTA TRAC – Transit Riders Adviory Committee 2016 Member Application for David Kovar

I have been an activist for transportation services in Pinellas country since retirement in 2003, in particular during the GLP campaign in 2013 – 2014. My other social justice activities include working with the multi-congregation FAST coalition as a member of the Unitarian Universalists of Clearwater. I am the Vice President of the Humanist Society of the Suncoast, and serve as its program chairman. Under its banner organization "Tampa Bay Post-Carbon Council" I've rallied for GLP and partnered with the Sierra Club's CleanSkies solar power efforts and Drive Electric programs and have sponsored informational programs on Global Warming. I was a strong advocate for the original Florida high speed rail initiative overturned by the "devious plan" of Governor Bush, as well as the one who's funding was refused by Governor Scott.

I am retired on a full disability from balance issues that leave me immobile in an erratic unpredictable manner. While now under control, affecting me minimally, this condition will only grow worse with age. I expect to become dependent on public transportation at an age earlier than most. The GreenLight plan offered me a vision of living along the 4th street rail line, in high density senior housing, with fast easy access to the entire bay area, just as my ability to drive began to falter.

In my 25 year working career, I was a million-mile business travel and a frequent transit user in cities like Chicago, Atlanta, Boston, Washington, and the Bay Area. Our offices were usually located in central cities making transit an easy option, despite rental cars made available by company travel policy and used by most of my coworkers. Even where our offices did not allow transit use (LA, Detroit, New Jersey, DFW), I am familiar with the transit networks and capabilities. I've traveled throughout the 48 contiguous states, and many western European countries. To be fair, I retired in 2003, so have kept abreast of the newest transit systems (PHX, DEN, SLC) via my internet news subscriptions and contacts in those cities. The same for world wide high speed rail systems.

I am a subscriber and regular reader of Better Cities and Towns, the publication of the Congress of New Urbanism out of the University of Miami. Unfortunately, I was not able to attend one of their national conferences due to my health. I'm a years long listener of the futurist James Kunstler's podcast, well versed in green construction, population patterns, high-level business and land-use regulations, a high volume internet user, and was a member of the now defunct meetup group for Shared Housing in the Bay Area.

For access and fuel economy, I ride a 250cc scooter locally, and 650cc scooter for highway travel. I live within a block of the shared stop for the 62 and Safety Harbor Trolley and use those when ill, or for evening entertainment.

I have always volunteered in the Pinellas County Public School system. I started out in the library at Skyview, was a parent volunteer at Transfiguration Catholic School and finished as a Booster Club member at Largo High School.

I bring my previous experience as a car owner and full-time employee with UPS as a dispatcher and problem solver. I bring my current experience as a retired wheelchair-dependent rider on public transportation and Social Security. I see PSTA from both sides of the financial spectrum. I even bring experience combining the two ends of the spectrum while I was still working but beginning to depend on PSTA.

I have been volunteering with ARC for two years at the Long Center in Clearwater. I ride my power scooter 20 minutes to catch bus 62. I used to take bus 79 to mass at St. Jude's Cathedral but it is unbearable being on a bus 5 hours a day for one hour of mass. My friends now help pay for DART. Bus 74 and 79 are the buses I use to run my shopping errands. I call DART for scheduled appointments to make sure I get there on time and not suffer the Florida weather.

I want to be a member of this committee because I develop in my mind the potential that PSTA can offer. While I daydream, I watch other riders suffer limited routes, runs and limited hours trying to raise families and bring home a paycheck. It is not the fault of PSTA that it doesn't serve Pinellas County as well as PSTA supporters would like. The failings of PSTA went unnoticed by me as an occasional rider. I was able to get myself to my job temporarily but didn't struggle with two buses and a ½ mile long scooter ride long enough to criticize PSTA. My ride to work in my van took 15 minutes. By bus, it took over an hour. Looking back, that was the time to get involved.

I hold the Ridership accountable. There is a lot of complaining but there is no activism. Improving the mass transportation system in Pinellas County is as much about educating the riders as the public. Ideally riders would be doing the educating themselves instead of being angry. PSTA also needs a mental image upgrade. Our bus system is not a steppingstone towards earning enough money to get a car. Non-riders and riders alike view riding the bus as a step down. Our buses are as fancy as the ones we see in the movies. Our drivers and customer service representatives are congenial and solve our problems. Rarely have I had a run in with the driver and when I did the customer service center handled my call. I see mass transportation as a way to solve problems.

I look forward to sharing ideas about what the Transit Riders Advisory Committee can do to bring about a new way of thinking about and respecting our Pinellas County mass transit system

1. Just moved to the area from Broward County, Florida, and lived in Pinellas County from 2003-2012. Before I moved from Broward (Margate), I volunteered at the public library, with my church (taught children ages 8-11), and taught beginner computer classes where I lived (a 55+ community). I worked full-time at a local hospital emergency room. I have volunteer online with the U.S. Geological Survey, Bird Phenology program, as a data entry volunteer (bird records from 1850-1970) and Family Search, indexing and abstracting genealogical records for about 6-7 years.

2. I have accomplished much in spite of having multiple sclerosis since the age of 24 (I am 52). I have a B.A. in Biology and have worked in a medical research laboratory, as a pharmacy tech, universities and hospital emergency rooms. I have volunteered with the Clearwater Aquarium (2004-2005), Special Olympics, Arthritis Foundation, other libraries and online.

3. As a disabled and <u>active</u> community member (Hispanic as well), I can bring my experience as such a person and what it is like to take the bus everywhere.
