

# Surface Transportation Program Priority Project Request to MPO

PSTA Board Meeting February 25, 2015

### **Bus Fleet Replacements**

- FTA useful life for buses:
  - 35' or larger: 12 years or 500k miles
  - 29': 10 years or 350k miles
  - Connectors: 5 years or 150k miles



- PSTA buses average 50,000 miles per year
  - Policy decision: Extend useful life of buses to 15+ years
  - \$8M annual shortfall in bus replacement capital
- Discretionary monies for bus and bus facilities
  - Converted to formula program in MAP-21
  - PSTA received \$1.4M in 2014



## **STP Program**

- Flexible Funding
  - Projects that preserve and improve conditions
  - Federal-Aid Highway, Ped/Bike, Transit Capital
- Pinellas averages \$14M/year (5 year average in TIP)
  - Historically used to supplement state road projects
  - 5% of total FDOT dollars received by Pinellas
- Priority list used to allocate other funding as available
