SERVICE FACTS

- Length of Route: 20 miles round trip
- Proposed Stops: 31 stations
- **Proposed Frequency:** Daytime: Bus every 15 min. Evening: Bus every 30 min.
- **Proposed Service Span:** 6 a.m. to Midnight
- # of Jobs within ½ mile of Corridor: 50K
- # of People within ½ mile of Corridor: 40K
- Project Cost: \$43.93M



Pinellas Suncoast Transit Authority's (PSTA) Central Avenue Bus Rapid Transit (BRT) project is the first project in the Tampa Bay Region to ever advance in the federal Capital Investment Grant Program (CIG) process and receive a medium-high rating, the second highest rating possible.

Project features include:

- Quicker boarding and alighting process:
 - Level boarding platforms
 - Bikes on buses
 - Off-board fare payment systems with ticket vending machines at select locations
 - Real-time bus arrival information
- Rapid service:
 - Buses on semi-dedicated lanes
 - Higher frequency
 - Limited stops
 - Transit signal priority

The service will connect several key destinations providing reliable transportation to residents, workers and tourists!
